**AWARD INFORMATION:**

The Union League Civic & Arts Foundation will award a total of \$1,800 in awards for Jazz Composition as follows:

- High School & College: \$600
- Graduate: \$1,200

**ENTRANCE RULES:**

1. The entrant must be:
  - Living and/or studying within a 100-mile radius of the Chicago Loop.
2. The composition:
  - Must be an original jazz composition for any number of voices or instruments.
  - Can be any length and form.
  - May be consistent with what you, or others, are doing in composition classes.
3. Each entrant may submit as many as three compositions.
4. Entrants may submit their applications by mail or electronically. Entrants are encouraged but not required to submit live or electronic recordings (in Finale, etc.), preferably in CD format. Entrant must also submit two copies of the score and a completed entry form. Scores and entry forms may also be submitted online at [www.civicanarts.org](http://www.civicanarts.org).

**TO THE ENTRANTS:**

- The judges will reserve the right to withhold the award if, in their opinion, the composition does not merit the award.
- The Civic & Arts Foundation may request a performance of the winning composition to take place at a Foundation event. The Foundation may pay an honorarium to assist in the public performance of the work at the event.
- Awards may be given at a CAF event or mailed.

**GENERAL AWARD INFORMATION:**

- Union League Club and Foundation employees are not eligible.
- The Union League Civic & Arts Foundation reserves the right to use the awardees' names and songs on our website and in our publications.
- Awardees are requested to list the Union League Civic & Arts Foundation in all publicity releases.
